What you should bring:

A desire to learn and improve (a teachable attitude). Centerfire or .22 rimfire rifle, or both.

Scope OK. Sling strongly recommended.
250 rounds of ammunition per day, per rifle.

Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth.

Hat and sunscreen. Rain gear, layered clothes.

Water – food on site. Some friends!

What you can expect:

New shooters - learn the fundamentals and make quick progress.

Experienced shooters - learn techniques to tighten your groups.

Expert shooters - polish your shooting AND teaching skills.
